



## Business Inspections

Lyndon Fire Protection District is committed to the safety and security of our local businesses and their customers, guests and employees. In compliance with The International Fire Code, the Kentucky Standards of Safety (Fire Prevention Code) and local ordinance, the District has established a program of periodic inspections of all business locations within the boundaries of the district. The periodic inspections may take the form of a self-inspection or a full inspection by fire department personnel.

Self-inspections are suitable for low risk/low occupancy locations and are performed by the business owner or occupant by following a certified inspection checklist. Once the check list is completed the results are provided to the fire department through an Internet based portal or, alternatively, by return mail.

Full inspections by fire department personnel are for businesses with relatively higher risks or hazards and are performed during the business day. These inspections are performed quickly and efficiently with the assistance of iPad technology, resulting in minimal disruption of a business's operations. Any deficiencies noted during the inspection process are communicated to the business and will result in a re-inspection once the issue has been corrected.

On an annual basis District personnel will designate business occupancies as self or full inspections based upon their knowledge of and experience with each location. However, a business assigned to self-inspection status may request and receive a full inspection.

Business owners will be charged a minimal fee for both types of inspections to help defray the costs of these programs.

The District has contracted with Fire Recovery USA, LLC to assist with the inspection programs. This company specializes in assisting fire departments across the country by providing technology and billing expertise that enables departments, like Lyndon Fire Protection District, to operate more efficiently and effectively thereby reducing their administrative burden.
